To use Google Pay for in store payments, ensure that your device supports Near Field Communication (NFC) and Host Card Emulation (HCE) functions. You can make in-app or online payments with Google Pay even if your device does not have NFC capabilities.
4	How many cards can I add per device?	You may add multiple eligible CIMB Mastercard® Credit Cards to your Google Pay on each device.
5	Can I add my Card on multiple Google Pay devices?	Yes, you may add your CIMB Mastercard® Credit Card to multiple devices, but you will need to set your Card up on each device separately.
6	How do I make payments with Google Pay?	In order to make payments with Google Pay, you must first add your card to the Google Pay application in your compatible device.
